



**ATTENTION WYOMING FARMER'S MARKET DIRECTORS
CHEF DEMONSTRATION "Crops to Cuisine" GRANT**

The Wyoming Department of Agriculture received a grant to have chef demonstrations at farmer's markets in Wyoming. The grant will go through the Wyoming Farmers' Marketing Association. Upon review of the applications 2 markets will be selected for the 2008 season, each market will receive \$4000 each.

Purpose:

Demonstrations will offer customers and retail buyer's alternatives to cooking with Wyoming specialty produce. Crops to Cuisine program will offer demonstrations on how to use market produce and recipe cards for home preparation.

Requirements:

Grant of \$4000 will cover the following costs:

- Minimum of two demonstrations during the market season
- Chefs – if the chef does not donate their time
- Food costs
- Required permits
- Developing and printing of recipe cards
- Required equipment or lease
- Meet requirements of local health or agriculture department
- Meet requirements of local fire department or State Fire Marshal
- Submit a written report including financial expenditures, recipe cards, feedback and outcomes to the Wyoming Farmers' Marketing Association
- A presentation at the Annual Wyoming Farmers' Marketing Association Conference
- Recipe cards must be printed and mailed to other Wyoming farmer's markets. Average market would get 380 cards.
