The Wyoming Agricultural Experiment Station invites applications for summer graduate student support up to \$1,500, which can partially cover summer salary, travel, or supplies. Applications will be reviewed and evaluated against the criteria outlined in this request. The proposal should be submitted by the student's major professor.

Preference will be given to students working in the general areas of plant sciences or range resource management and for agricultural economics students conducting interdisciplinary work involving plant sciences or range resource management.

Describe, in not more than one page, the research project being conducted at SAREC and how the money would be used.

Graduate students should be doing the majority of their work at SAREC. The project's purpose should be applied research with necessary outreach and educational components to disseminate findings to producers and other user groups.
